Bitches in season will be allowed but will be moved to the end of the class in **test** classes. Please notify the Test/Trial Secretary if your bitch is in season.

There will no food vendor at the trial. There are several fast-food options within 15 minutes of the site. Please plan accordingly.

ALL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RULES REGARDING CONDUCT WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of the club after closing of entries.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.

NO CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED.

COVID 19 WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED AND INCLUDED WITH ENTRY.

There are no on-line entries for these events.

A separate entry blank for each class must be completed for each dog entered. If the dog is being entered in the identical class or classes for both Saturday and Sunday, you may simply check both boxes indicating the day entered. If your dog is entered in a different class each day, please fill out separate entry forms.

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the 'Current' Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Owners or their agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the test/trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test/Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the test/trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Exhibitors are responsible for calculating entry fees; refunds due to exhibitor error are at the option of the club.

All regulations regarding the use of this facility, and all regulation and decisions of the trial committee at this show will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the information in this premium list.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth in the official American Kennel Club entry form for this event.

There shall be no drilling or intensive or abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have proper vaccinations.

Children must be under the supervision of their parent or guardian at all times. Non-compliance with this rule will force the committee to ask them to leave the premises.

ALTERNATE LIST and MOVE_UPs

Entrants on the alternate's list must check in with the Herding Secretary on the grounds no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their level. **Note: Requests to move-up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to start of the event.** Alternates must run in their respective levels if present and if provided with the opportunity to run.

In tests and for move-ups from a test level to a trial level, alternate entries shall be given priority over dogs that are eligible to be moved-up. Within the trial levels, requests to move-up shall be given priority over alternate entries.

Alternates will be permitted to run if there is an absentee in an earlier level (provided the alternate's level has not begun) which was not filled on the same course, same type of livestock and under the same Judge, or if a dog has been marked absent with the Event Secretary prior to the beginning of the alternate's level.
